NWFA Announces Community Service Award Recipients

ST. LOUIS, Missouri (May 5, 2011) – The National Wood Flooring Association announced its 2011 Community Service Award recipients during its convention in San Diego, CA. The awards were announced during an Awards Dinner held on Wednesday, April 27. NWFA Community Service Awards are presented to companies that perform volunteer work for charitable organizations.

This past year, despite continued economic strain, five NWFA member companies found the time, the means, and the compassion to give to others. Their volunteerism ranges from restoring flooring in historic buildings in their communities, donating materials to provide housing for families in need, matching and replacing antique parquet flooring, refinishing the gym floors at a local private school which then used the money saved to provide a scholarship for a student in need, providing materials to makeover rooms for chronically ill bed-ridden children, and providing materials and labor to rebuild homes for families devastated by Hurricane Katrina. NWFA members volunteer their time, their materials, and their expertise to make our communities better places, and this award recognizes that effort.
